## **ELIGIBLE PARTICIPANTS MUST:**

- ► Be a resident of the Village of Lansing
- Have a valid Lansing library card or be eligible to receive a library card
- Be confined to their residence either temporarily due to illness or accident, or permanently due to age, disability or other mobility issues.
  - This includes nursing homes and assisted living facilities as well as caregivers or homebound residents.
  - We also serve late-term or post-pregancy mothers.
  - In most circumstances, if a resident drives, they would not be considered eligible for home delivery.



Materials will be delivered to and picked up from each participant's residence. Library staff will not enter the participant's residence unless accompanied by another staff member. Staff will not provide assistance with activities of daily living or advice on financial or personal matters.

Library staff may recommend suspension of home delivery service if any of the following conditions exist.

- Any person in the home presents threatening, obscene, or abusive language, gestures, or images.
- Any person in the home harasses a library representative.
- Any person in the home engaging in illegal activity.
- Any person in the home exhibiting signs of illness that may endanger the health of a library representative.
- The condition of the home and/or property is unsafe or unsanitary.

The Lansing Public Library has the right to refuse or terminate this service to any individual who does not meet the terms and requirements as defined above.





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Homebound Delivery at the Lansing Public Library provides library services to Lansing residents of all ages who are unable to physically come to the library.
